Located in the southern Peloponnesian peninsula, Pavlopetri (the modern name of the site) emerged as a Neolithic settlement around 3500 B.C. and became an important trading center for Mycenaean Greece (1650–1180 B.C.). This area of the Aegean Sea is <u>1</u> to earthquakes and tsunamis, which caused the city to <u>2</u> sink. The slow sea level rise in Mediterranean <u>3</u> this city around 3,000 years ago.

For millennia, the city's <u>4</u> lay unseen below some 13 feet of water. They were covered by a thick layer of sand <u>5</u> the island of Laconia. In recent decades, shifting <u>6</u> and climate change have eroded a natural barrier that <u>7</u> Pavlopetri. In 1967 a scientific survey of the Peloponnesian coast was <u>8</u> data to analyze changes in sea levels <u>9</u> British oceanographer Nicholas Flemming first spotted the sunken <u>10</u>. A year later, he returned with a few students to <u>11</u> the location and map the site. <u>12</u> the exciting initial finds, the site would lie <u>13</u> for decades before archaeologists would return.

In 2009 archaeologists Chrysanthi Gallou and Jon Henderson <u>14</u> the excavation of Pavlopetri in cooperation with the Greek Ministry of Culture. Since the 1960s, underwater archaeology <u>15</u> and tools had made huge advances. The team <u>16</u> robotics, sonar mapping, and state-of-the-art graphics to survey the site. From 2009 to 2013 they were able to bring the underwater town to <u>17</u>. Covering about two and a half acres, Pavlopetri's three main roads <u>18</u> some 50 rectangular buildings, all of which had open courtyards. Excavations revealed a large number of Minoan-style loom weights, <u>19</u> Pavlopetri was a thriving trade center with a <u>20</u> textile industry.
